It can be submitted as an original, hand drawn design (must be drawn in black), as a jpg file (at least 300 dpi), a pdf file, or on a CD as a vector file. The winning design will become the property of Habitat for Humanity West Hawaii and will be used on promotional materials for the event.

1. Make a new document in Illustrator 8.5 x 11 landscape
2. The Blitz Build is where volunteers from this organization will build 5 homes in 10 days for local worthy families
3. **I would concentrate 1st** only on creating a logo design for the **Laulima Na ‘Ohana – Working Together for the Families---** so..... be thinking again Hawaiian Style art, plants, maybe kids-family for the ohana part, a house with kids around it, a sun over a house, etc....
4. We will add the other logos LATER as part of the design process
